VVT Webinar Follow Up

Steve Burke of Schaeffler Group USA provided the following answer to a question following his highly regarded webinar on variable valve timing:

"In general, it's a good idea to stay with the original oil viscosities that are recommended by the manufacturer. There can be differences in performance if lower viscosities are used because of increased leakage in the system. Too much leakage may result in excessive pressure loss and slower phasing response. This can also affect stability and the phaser's ability to minimize oscillations in the system. As you probably know, viscosity is related to temperature and the engine is usually operating in the range or 90 to 100°C (194-212°F). Oil viscosity at this temperature range is particularly important.

Higher viscosity oil grades may improve leakage by reducing it, but it may also affect cold start performance by decreasing response times due to the flow being more restricted getting through orifices and filters. However, depending on the engine manufacturer and their control strategy, the VVT system may not activate until a certain temperature is reached anyway.

I recommend staying as close to your engine's original oil grade as possible and avoid straying too far from the viscosity, especially at the 90-100C operating temperature."

SimTest
