

Our keynote speaker this year will be Mike Staver who specializes in leadership skills. Mike is not only an accomplished speaker, but a renowned author. You won't want to miss Mike's address!

Wednesday will be another full day of great topics. The morning technical session will start off with Andy Markel, editor of Babcox's *Underhood Magazine* who will talk about direct injection and the myriad of issues that can affect your rebuilds. Jasper will follow that with a presentation on the 3.6L GM engine. They are going to talk about the many configurations of this multi-platform power plant.

After lunch, we'll cover piston rings with a 3-panel discussion by supplier members including Hastings Manufacturing, Mahle Aftermarket and NPR of America. Rings will be followed by a complete discussion on the failures of VVT and how you can correct them. This important topic will be presented by LKQ.

Thursday will start off with three speakers addressing the topic of valves. Ricardo Bastoni of Osvat Engine Valves in Italy will address new manufacturing; Casey Calouette of Cal Valves will talk about remanufactured valves; and Skip Hartley will close it with a discussion on reclaiming valves in your shops.

The tour for the non-golfers is set for Thursday afternoon at Mastercut Tools, a manufacturer of rotary cutting tools. This state-of-the-art plant is sure to open a lot of eyes.

We'll kick off Friday's program with another vendor discussion on engine bearings. This panel will be moderated by our own Doug Kaufman, Publisher/Editor of *Engine Builder Magazine*. Participating vendors will be ACL, King and Mahle Aftermarket.

The Friday tour for the full group will be in the afternoon, yes, afternoon. The program committee, through the survey feedback from Toronto, has expanded the technical program to include Friday morning pushing the tour to the afternoon.
